THE ISSUE: Penn State needed a new field hockey facility to accommodate the school's Division I field hockey team.

THE JOB: SCG was chosen to act as general contractor for the project and was responsible for preparing the site, developing the sub base and implementing a sophisticated drainage system fundamental to high performance field hockey fields. SCG was also in charge of managing the installation of an AstroTurf surface.
