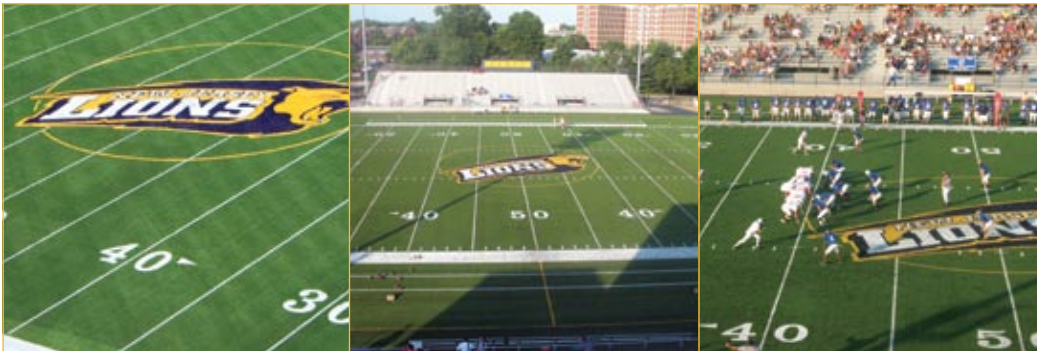


Scouting Report

THE ISSUE: After the College of New Jersey (TCNJ) learned that its aged synthetic field had potentially harmful levels of lead and heavy metals, the field was closed until the worn turf was removed and replaced. The college's graduation ceremony was scheduled for the coming months and the field needed to be restored under a tight deadline.
