



Latest, Most Grass-like Turf Coming to Brick Township, N.J.!

SCG Chosen to Install Two-Toned Monofilament from TigerTurf

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (September, 2007) Residents of Brick Township, N.J., may soon have a hard time distinguishing their two new synthetic field systems from natural grass as Sports Construction Group (SCG) finishes installing the “grassiest” looking turf available on the market to date.
